NYSEG – PR 455 Circuit

- Recording equipment installed on 9/3 (at Water Plant and VFD)
- Recloser adjustments made on 8/25 to reduce sensitivity → let's continue to monitor & log
- Tree trimming along the PR 455 Circuit completed in August
- NYSEG Resiliency team will make significant upgrades starting in the Spring of 2021
 - NYSEG will follow-up with more detail on above upgrades

Plant Operations & Maintenance

- 5 Wells are used to source water
- System flushing typically performed 2x per year
 - Consider 4x per year
- Chemical systems coupled with SCADA control system in use to mitigate
 - THMs
 - Iron & Manganese
 - PH value
 - Bacteria, etc.
- Water tested daily at entry point to distribution
 - Verification of clarity
 - Verification of proper removal of contaminants

Plant Operations & Maintenance, cont'd

- Oakridge WTP Inspection & Maintenance plan
- System flushing
 - Due to multiple reports of discoloration on 8/17 system was flushed on 8/25 and again on 9/16
 - Booster pump issues caused degraded flushing rate in past resulting in sediment buildup & inability to scour the inside of the mains
 - Now able to flush at >750 GPM by using both; booster pumps & the jockey pump, to achieve the scouring velocity
 - Dead ends of water distribution will require flushing hydrants
 - Propose installation of manually operated flushing hydrant
 - Starting process to obtain bids
 - Future: decide if looping or automatic flushing valves are needed

Financials

- P&L results available for 2019 & 2020
- 2020 Adopted budget
 - Oakridge water is on p.37.
- OWD has two Bond Anticipation Notes (BANs) outstanding.
 - The first one issued in 2003 has \$574,000 remaining and matures in 2043.
 - The second one issued in 2019 with \$482,500 outstanding matures in 2059
 - Issue in conjunction with the WIIA grant of \$289,500.
 - Both re-price annually and their current interest rate is 1.15%.

Trihalomethane (THM) project and funding/grant

- THMs were found in small amounts in the water in 2016
- THMs had been removed but upgrades needed to ensure THMs would not recur and required by state regulations
- Town Board authorized bonding for \$482.5K
 - Pre-requisite for Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) Grant
 - Initial grant application rejected in December 2018, re-applied in 2019 and received grant approval in December 2019

Short Term and Long Term plans

Short Term

- More frequent system flushes, i.e quarterly
- Installation of manually operation flushing hydrants in deadends
- Tank aeration

Long Term

- Automatic flush hydrants on dead-end loops (if needed)
- Alternative water source to well water, i.e. discussion with Aquarion Water
- Delaware Engineering improvement suggestions Review
