Dear Oakridge Residents,

VRI would like to make you aware of the current status of the sampling and notification that were collected and sent out by an outside contractor within Oakridge last week at 163 Laurel Ridge and the Pool House. VRI was not made aware that those samples were being taken, which is why a statement was not issued immediately.

Please know, our annual Lead & Copper samples that are required by New York State and The Westchester County Health Departments and are to be collected between June 1st and September 30th. We have pushed that sampling to be completed this week. Beginning in 2022, these samples will be taken every three (3) years as previous years' results have been in good standing and below the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) set forth and closely monitored by New York State and Westchester County Health Departments.

VRI will be collecting follow up samples at the locations previously sampled by the outside contractor to verify results and maintain transparency with the community.
