POSSIBLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE PROJECT BUDGET

- Typical consultant costs range widely based on scope, size, zoning
- Proposals received clustered around \$135,000 \$165,000
 - Additional costs depending on outreach, zoning code updates
- Associated project timelines range from 12 months 24 months
- Possible funding from grants, but timeline constrained
 - Steering Committee is already pursuing NYS grants
 - Consultant hired can provide guidance on additional grants
