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Town of Lewisboro supervisor updates are posted on the town's website, the Parks and Recreation Department website, and distributed by email by the town and Lewisboro Library via the town's and library's mailing lists. Town House

All Lewisboro town offices are closed. Leave a message for the department you are trying to reach and an official will return the call as soon as possible. Contact information for town departments can be found at lewisborogov.com.

Meetings

The Town Board is scheduled to conduct its second virtual meeting Monday, April 13, using Zoom, the videoconferencing tool. Other departments are also beginning to host virtual meetings and details on how to access the meetings will be provided in advance. Justice Court

Lewisboro Library

The library will continue to issue new or renew expired library cards remotely. Lewisboro Library card holders can access all Westchester County Library digital content offerings. Residents can reach the library by email at lewisborolibrary@gmail.com. The library is streaming a live storyline with Miss Anna on the library's Facebook page every Monday and Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. until the library reopens. In addition, Miss Anna will be streaming a live reading of "Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone" every Tuesday and Thursday at 3 p.m. Preschoolers and elementary students can join Miss Anna for Sonnet Duetts every Friday at 3:30 p.m., starting Friday, April 3, for crafts, trivia and science experiments.

Building Department

The Building Inspector is receiving calls forwarded from the town office number and will return phone messages. The town is only performing exterior inspections at the current time. To reach the Building Inspector, call the Building Department at 763-3060.

Highway Department

Town trucks are continuing to pour salt as needed for road maintenance. Service will be limited to handling emergency. For any questions, issues or concern, residents can email the office at highway@lewisborogov.com.

Tax Payments

Since town offices are closed, resi-

dents cannot pay their taxes inside the office and must use one of the town's other payment options. The April 2020 town and county tax bills can be paid starting Wednesday, April 1, and are due by Thursday, April 30. Payments can be made through mail by sending in the entire bill with a check in the exact amount to Lewisboro Tax Office, PO Box 422, So. Salem, NY 12550. Residents can also pay online at lewisborogov.com/receiver by using the secure online tax payment link on the Receiver of Taxes page. Payments by Fed Ex, UPS or DHL should be directed to Lewisboro Tax Office, 11 Main St., South Salem, NY 10590. Residents can also place tax payment envelopes in the temporary slot at the bottom of the Town House front door at 11 Main St., or in the mailbox at the back door of the Town House, where there is a newly-secured black mailbox for envelopes.

Recreation

The town has closed the parking lots of the following parks: Fox Valley Park, Lewisboro Town Park, Leon Levy Preserve, Onatru Farm Park (only the large parking lot in the back) and Vista Community Park. Residents can still access these parks and preserves by foot or bicycle. All playground equipment is closed.

The Parks and Recreation offices are closed. Two department employees are working to deliver Meals on Wheels and food shop for seniors during the week. Residents can reach the department at 232-6162.

Recycling

The recycling center is closed until further notice.

Resources for seniors

The town is working to contact local grocery stores to set up arrangements for home delivery. Seniors can take advantage of the Parks and Recreation department's Meals on Wheels program. Acme, Green Way Markets, DeCoco's and CVS provide home delivery through Instacart, the online ordering service. The town has also set up delivery services with The Market at Pound Ridge Square and Greenwich Produce in Vista.
