Honoring the Leon Levy Preserve

WHEREAS, the State of New York is proud to acknowledge its local landmarks and favorite attractions; and

WHEREAS, the Leon Levy Preserve will celebrate the tremendous progress made at the preserve on September 19, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Leon Levy Preserve contains 383 acres with five miles of trails featuring wetlands rich in wildlife, a ravine with 25-foot cliffs, views to the west as far as the Hudson River and a diverse hardwood forest; and

WHEREAS, the Leon Levy Preserve also boasts rare Purple Milkweed and Blue Cohosh plants; and

WHEREAS, the Leon Levy Preserve was purchased in 2005 by the Westchester Land Fund and the Town of Lewisboro; this was made possible by a \$5 million contribution from the Jerome Levy Foundation and \$500,000 from the Dextra Baldwin McGonagle Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the celebration will include the unveiling of a plaque which reads "Lewisboro thanks the Jerome Levy Foundation for its lead gift to create this preserve. Major valuable contributions were also made by the Dextra Baldwin McGonagle Foundation, the Westchester Land Trust, and the Lewisboro Land Trust together with the volunteers who give many hours of their time to clear and maintain the trails;" and

WHEREAS, following the unveiling, representatives of the benefactors will be invited to speak, followed by a talk by Pam Pooley, who designed the Preserve's native plant garden, and a guided short hike along the new trails; **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

RESOLVED, that I, as a duly elected member of the Senate of the State of New York, on behalf of the citizens thereof, do hereby congratulate the Leon Levy Preserve.

- **Right onto Gilbert Street to Hoyt Street and then to Country Lane;**
- **Take Country Lane to Boway Street;**
- **Right on Boway Road to Truesdale Lake Drive;**
- **Right onto Truesdale Lake Drive;**
- **Take Truesdale Lake Drive back to Lakeshore Drive;**
- **Right off of Lakeshore Drive onto Spring Street and to Finish Line.**


SUMMARY OF 10K RACE COURSE

- **Bear left onto Old Oscaleta Rd. to its ending with Main Street;**
- **Right turn onto Main Street;**
- **Left turn onto Boway Road;**
- **Take Boway all the way to Woodway Road;**
- **Left onto Woodway Road to Spring Street;**
- **Right onto Spring Street to Finish Line**
