LOCAL LAW NUMBER \_\_-2016 OF THE TOWN OF LEWISBORO

SECTION 1 -- TITLE

This Local Law shall be known as 2016 Amendments to Section 212-29 Schedule VIII: Parking Prohibited Certain Hours, of Chapter 212: Vehicles & Traffic.

SECTION 2 -- ADOPTION

Now therefore be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lewisboro Local Law \_\_-2016 that this law shall take effect immediately upon its passage:

SECTION 3 – VEHICLES & TRAFFIC

Section 212-29 of Chapter 212, Vehicles & Traffic, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Amend §212-29 – Schedule VIII: Parking Prohibited Certain Hours.**

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
-----------------------	-------------	-----------------

In accordance with the provisions of § 212-12, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours listed upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Hours/Days	Location
Anderson Lane	Both	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday	Entire Length
Gideon Reynolds Road	Both	7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday	For a distance of 750 feet west of the Intersection with Route 121
Green Street	Both	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday	Entire Length
Highway Department Dome Access Drive	Both	Monday through Friday	Entire Length
Spring Street	Both	Monday through Saturday (except holidays)	Route 35 to Main Street

SECTION 4 – HOME RULE

Nothing in this Local Law is intended, or shall be construed (a) to limit the home rule authority of the Town under State Law to limit the Town's discretion in setting fees and charges in connection with any applications requiring Town approval.

SECTION 5 -- SEVERABILITY

If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part of provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town of Lewisboro hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
